Tips for Healthy Tree Care

Trees Hamilton has watered, mulched and put a protective collar around the trunk of your tree.

Follow these tips to keep it healthy:

- Water your tree weekly for the first year from late spring to early fall; after the first year, water the tree weekly only when it hasn't rained much.
- Check the soil around the base of your tree to make sure it is moist, not drenched or muddy.
- Don't fertilize your tree for the first two years.
- Protect your new tree from lawn mowers and grass trimmers.
- Keep weed killers away from your tree.
- Keep woodchips and or mulch around the base of your tree to keep it moist and prevent weeds. Keep at a minimum depth of 10 cm (4 inches) to a maximum depth of 15 cm (6 inches).
